RULES

- Start time: 11am Normal Finish: 12:30pm
- All cards must be in by 1:30pm
- Do not open cards!!! (Judges will open all envelopes)
- You must have 6 (six) cards – #1 thru #6 inclusive
- One card must be discarded unopened (your choice)
- Must follow route

2018 POKER RUN DIRECTIONS

- Starting from Parksville Curling Club in the Parksville Community Park...
- Proceed from Parksville Curling Club parking lot . Turn right on Corfield St. N. and go up to stoplights at Hwy. 19A and **turn right**.
- Continue on Hwy. 19A **driving in the left lane** to the second stoplight (**.3 miles**), which is Hwy 4A (Alberni Highway) and **turn left** at the lights.
- Follow Hwy 4A through the second stoplight at Despard Ave. **keeping in the left lane** and go under the highway overpass. Continue to the Pinetree Centre (1343 Alberni Hwy) (**2.6 miles**) and **turn right** into the parking lot entrance to **pick-up your 1st card**. Exit from the parking lot turning right onto Hwy. 4A .
- Continue on Hwy 4A through the lights at Church Rd. (Co-Op gas station on corner) and stay on Hwy. 4A through the village of Coombs (famous for the Goats on the Roof market) to the stoplight at Hwy. 4A and Hwy 4 (T-intersection) (**4.5 miles**) where you will turn **left onto Hwy. 4** heading towards Port Alberni.
- Stay on Hwy. 4 until you reach the **left turn** entrance into the Whiskey Creek CO-OP gas station and **Island Drive-In Restaurant (3.0 miles)** where you will **pick-up your 2nd card**. Turn around in parking lot and return to Hwy. 4 and **turn right**.
- Continue on the highway back towards Qualicum Beach , straight through the lights at the T-intersection of Hwy 4A, and under the highway overpass . Just a short distance past the highway overpass **turn right** into the **Qualicum Beach Information Pulloff (5.2 miles)** and **pick-up your 3rd. card**.
- Return to the highway, continue to the roundabout at Rupert Rd. and take the second exit heading down Memorial Ave. into Qualicum Beach.
- Proceed down Memorial Ave, through the stoplight at Fern Rd. (Quality Foods on the corner) , over the railway tracks, continuing to Elizabeth Street (**1.7 miles**) where you will **turn right** and then your **second left** into the **Qualicum Beach Inn** where you will **pick-up your 4th card**.
- Proceed straight through the parking lot and **turn right** onto Hwy. 19A heading back towards Parksville.
- Drive several miles back into Parksville , past the Parksville Community Park (where you started) and then keeping in the right lane, **turn right** at Mill St. (**7.3 miles**) and then immediately left into the **Family Ford** dealership and **pick-up your 5th card**.
- Continue through the dealership and **turn right** back onto the highway.

POKER RUN DIRECTIONS (CONTINUED)

- Follow Hwy. 19A **in the left lane**, over the Orange Bridge and proceed until you get to first set of lights which is Resort Way (**1.6 miles**). Enter the left hand turn lane and **turn left** onto Resort Way.
- Drive to the stop sign and **turn left** again onto Resort Drive.
- Follow Resort Dr. (**.6 miles**) until you reach the **Log Cabin Convenience Store** and **pick-up your 6th card**. Exit straight ahead to the stop sign and head back towards Parksville on Hwy. 19A.
- Follow the highway back over the Orange Bridge, continue to the stoplight (**1.4 miles**) at Corfield St. **Turn right** to Parksville Community Park and **turn left** to the Parksville Curling Club starting location.
- **Turn In your six cards.**

2018 POKER RUN HIGHLIGHTS

- Registration **maximum** for the Poker Run is **150 vehicles**. Your paid registration fee of \$5.00 entitles you to a **Free 2018 Poker Run Souvenir** gift (one per vehicle).
- Food is available for your enjoyment. Catering trucks will provide a breakfast & snack menu before and a lunch menu after the Poker Run Event.
- Prizes awarded for best Poker Hands submitted.
